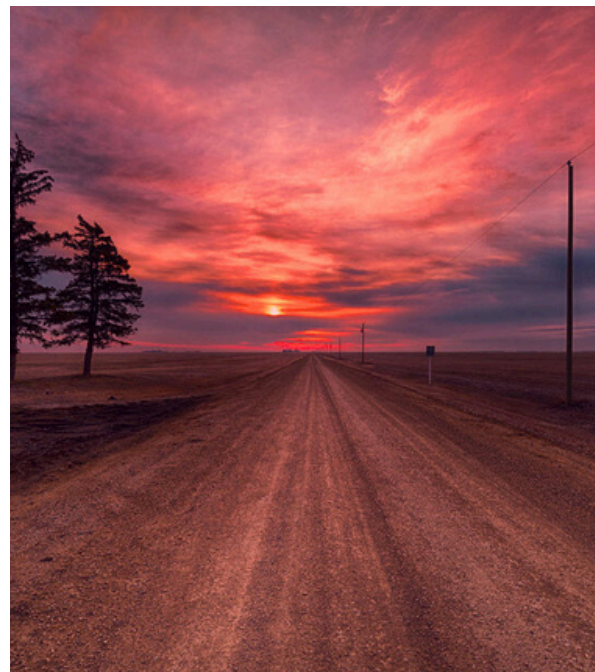
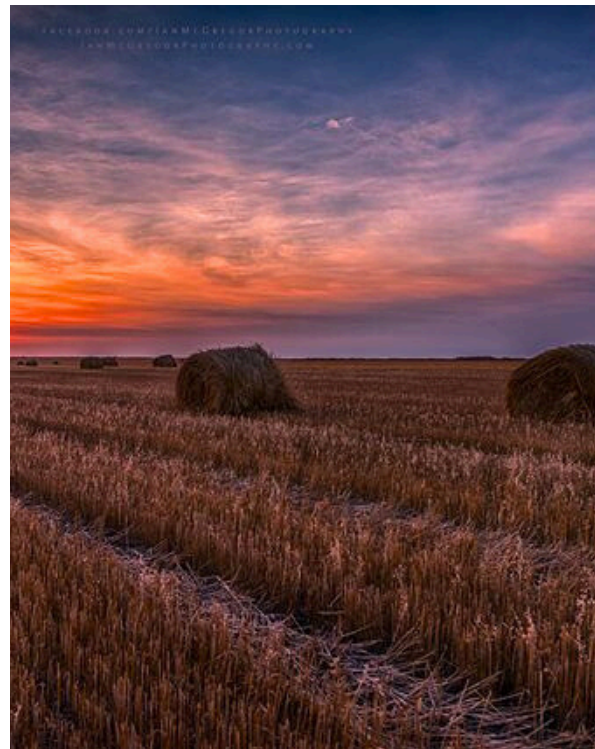
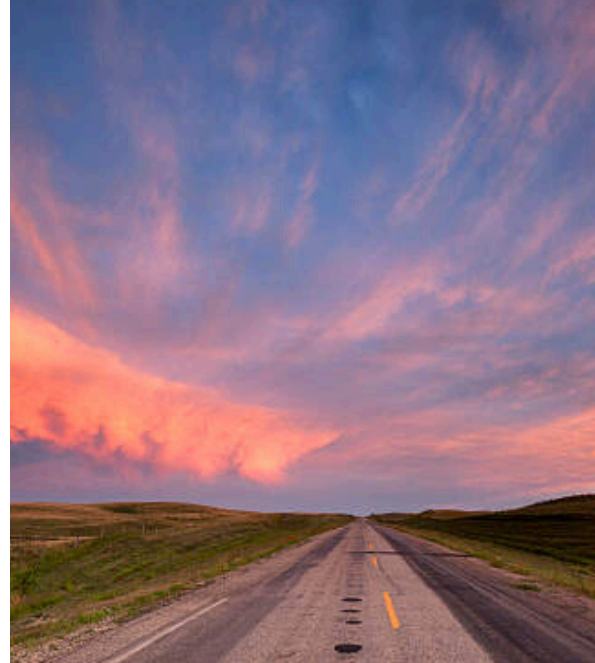

FEIS RULES

1. Competitions are only open to amateurs.
2. Only students of teachers registered in good standing with the WCIDTA, the IDTANA, and the CLRG may compete.
3. Entries to all feiseanna must receive approval from the competitor's teacher.
4. Competitors ages will be determined as of January 1st of the current year.
5. Music shall be in accordance with regulation metronome speeds.
6. Categories:

First Feis: A dancer who has never previously competed in a registered competition.
Beginner: A dancer who has not qualified for Advanced Beginner in that particular dance.
Adv Beg: A dancer who has received a qualifying place in that particular dance in the Beginner level but has not yet qualified to move on to Novice in that particular dance.
Novice: A dancer who has received a qualifying place in that particular dance in the Advanced Beginner level but has not yet qualified to move on to Prizewinner for that particular dance.
Prizewinner: A dancer who has received a qualifying place in that particular dance in the Novice Level but has not yet qualified to advance to Preliminary Championships.

First Feis Trophy: (Reel 32 bars)
 Open to dancers entered in their first feis. Dancers may not compete in any other Trophy competition.

Beginner/Advanced Trophy: (Reel, 32 bars)
 Open to dancers who dance the majority of their dances in the Beginner or Advanced Beginner level in solos.

Novice/Prizewinner Trophy: (Treble Jig or Hornpipe, 32 bars, choice of speed)
 Open to dancers who dance the majority of their dances in the Novice or Prizewinner level in solos. Also, open to dancers who have previously won two first place trophies in the Beginner/Advanced Beginner Trophy competitions. Dancers in ALL age groups will dance the Treble Jig or Hornpipe.

Preliminary Championships: Open to dancers who have won two first place trophies in the Novice/Prizewinner Trophy competition, and who have not previously won three first place Preliminary Championships with 5 or more dancers.

Option B - one soft shoe round AND one hard shoe round AND one Non-Traditional Set Dance (U9 & younger do a Trad) may be dances, in which case, the Feis Committee would offer this trophy dance instead of Preliminary solos. Solo marks will be given for each round, and an overall Championship prize will be awarded.

Open Championships: Open to dancers who have previously won three first place Preliminary Championships with 5 or more dancers. **Option B.**

Specials: Specials do not qualify dancers to advance in grade levels. Please enter your dancer in specials based on the levels of their trophy dances. (ie. If they dance the Beginner/Advanced Beginner Trophy, then their specials are also in that level).

7. Dancers may only dance solo grade level dances once in a feis. Dancers entered in First Feis competitions may also dance in beginner for those dances.
 In Figure Dancing, 50% of a team may be moved to a higher age group to complete a figure, unless the Feis Committee has granted special permission. All Ceili dances must be performed in accordance with the Official Book "An Rinci Foirne."
8. A competition may be cancelled or combined with a higher age group if there are less than five entries. Competitions may also be split if needed.
9. Dancers should be in the hall 60 minutes prior to their competition start time.
 All dancers must be in costume, complete with shoes and number to receive any award onstage.
10. Under no circumstances are the adjudicators or musicians to be approached during the feis. The decision of the adjudicator is final.
11. No steel taps or bubble heels allowed. Shoes may be subject to inspection by adjudicators. Costumes must be in accordance with the IDTANA and CLRG guidelines.
12. The River City Feis Committee, the WCIDTA, the RCIDPA, the venue and the River City School of Irish Dance are not responsible for personal injury, property loss or damage during the event. Protest against breach of the rules will be considered if made in writing and signed by the objector.
13. The objection must also be accompanied with a \$50 fee and reach the River City Feis Committee before prizes are presented. If the complaint is justified, the \$50 fee will be refunded.
14. Competitors may only compete in the Trophy competition or a Championship but not both. 'Specials' (as noted above) do not apply.
15. No personal video devices or equipment shall be allowed in the hall, including digital recording devices. This is a CLRG rule.
16. The "River City Feis" committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
 Dancers shall advance in each individual solo dance as follows:

Number of dancers in the competition	Placing that moves dancer up
< 5	No placing advances
5 - 9	1st place moves up
10 - 19	1st, 2nd, 3rd move up
20 - 29	1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th move up
30 +	1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th move up

17. Dancers shall advance in Trophy comps and Championship as follows:

A dancer who:	Moves up to:
Wins 2 first place trophies in Advanced Beginner Trophy	Moves up to Novice/Prizewinner Trophy
Has majority of hard shoe dances in Novice and Prizewinner	Moves up to Novice/Prizewinner Trophy
Wins 2 first place Novice/Prizewinner Trophies	Moves up to Preliminary Championship
Wins 3 first place Preliminary Championships with 5 or more dancers	Moves up to Open Championship

18. All Feis Committees must award a minimum of 30% of competitors in Preliminary and Open Championships.
19. Shiny plastic number cards should not be used, matte ones are allowed.
20. All other Feis rules as per the CLRG, IDTANA and the WCIDTA.

We will be hosting Grade Exams on Friday, May 29, 2026. Registration is open to any dancer with their TCRG's permission. Once all entries are in we will release an approximate schedule, followed by a detailed timeline. Due to offering exams on just one day, spaces are limited and will be given on a first come first served basis.

Please wait to receive a confirmation email **prior** to sending in payment.

All payments can be made by etransfer to: nicole@yxeirish.com. Please be sure to make note of your dancer's name and the grades they're registered for in the etransfer memo. Example: Seamus Finnegan Grades 3 & 4. All registrations must be paid to secure your space in the exam.

As a reminder, you can take up to 3 grade levels at once. All dancers must be able to provide their prior completed exams to the examiner. The required paperwork is the prior Marking Sheet, NOT the prior certificate.

RULES

1. A dancer may only take 3 grades at any one exam. Grades 11 and 12 must be taken on their own.
2. A three month period must elapse before the next grade is attempted.
3. Grade exams must be examined by at least 4 examiners up to grade 10 plus two different full examiners for grades 11 and 12.
4. A choice of examiners by the teacher is allowed up to grade 6, using a minimum of 2 examiners through these grades.
5. From grade 7-10 the examiner is appointed by the Udarás from the rotation list.
6. A dancer would be permitted to retake any grade for a better score upon submission of a specific written request to the Udarás Scrúdaithe, with the understanding that the second result would replace the earlier one and that the dancer would be required to pay the usual fee for the grade being taken.
7. All 12 Grade exams must be completed to be eligible to apply for the TCRG examination.
8. All candidates must produce previous reports before proceeding to higher grades. Please bring to exam.
9. A candidate must take all grades in order, beginning with Grade 1 (the Preliminary grade is optional).
10. 40 bars of music must be danced for all Reels, Single or Hop Jigs, Light Jigs, Slip Jigs, Heavy Jigs and Hornpipes.
11. Dance costumes must not be worn. Practice clothes are acceptable.

GRADES 11 & 12 APPLICATION GUIDELIES

1. Special application forms must be submitted for these exams. The application forms for Grade 11 and Grade 12 is linked at the bottom of this page. Be sure to complete the Registration form (linked at top) and then submit the rest of your application by email.
2. Application and documentation for Grades 11 and 12 MUST be submitted by March 26, 2026. however, there are limited spots so it is first come first serve.
3. Grades 11 and 12 will be conducted by S.D.C.R.G. examiners.
 - a. Candidates must be at least 16 years or older to take grade 11.
 - b. Candidates must be at least 17 years or older to take grade 12.
 - c. A different S.D.C.R.G. examiner must examine each of grades 11 and 12.
 - d. The results of grades 11 and 12 are not given to the candidates until they have been ratified.
4. Grades 11 and 12 require that all previous grade exam reports are to be submitted along with the specific application form (linked above) to nicole@yxeirish.com and we will submit them to the CLRG for approval on your behalf.
